 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

D E. JONES
 JUNTURA OR 97911

confirms the right to use the waters of MALHEUR RIVER, TRIBUTARY TO SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 10.3 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 228. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 1888. The amount of water to which such right is entitled for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.5 acre-feet per acre in any 30 day period prior to June 1st, 1.0 acre-foot per acre in any 30 day period after June 1st of each year, or 3.0 acre-feet per acre during any season, diverted at a rate not to exceed one-twentieth of a cubic foot per second per acre.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the old point of diversion described as follows:

20 S	39 E	WM	25	SE SW

When in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices. That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled. That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring devices be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 26, 1981, at Special Order Volume 34, Page 397, approving Transfer Application T-4679, and together with Certificate 99230, supercedes Certificate 49067, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
