CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CRAIG PRITCHARD
RT 1 BOX 69
BOARDMAN, OR 97818

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED DRAINAGEWAY, a tributary to the COLUMBIA RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 85.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-49571. The date of priority is AUGUST 9, 1985. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.79 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

4 N	25 E	WM	13	NW SW	50 FEET SOUTH AND 700 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply from other sources under prior existing rights for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
