confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-5571. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: SOUTH FORK OF WALLOWA RIVER (ALSO KNOWN AS LOSTINE RIVER), A TRIBUTARY OF WALLOWA RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 38.6 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.49 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: AUGUST 11, 1922

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device at the point of diversion. If the Director notifies the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other measuring device, the water user shall install such device specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain and operate a fish screen at the point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.


The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 30, 2012, at Special Order Volume 88, Page 199, approving Transfer Application 9715, and together with Certificate 87709, supersedes Certificate 3922, State record of Water Right Certificates.
