CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LOLA E. ELLIOTT
HEREFORD OR

confirms the right to use the waters of FLINT CREEK, TRIBUTARY of BURNT RIVER for the purpose of IRRIGATION and STORAGE.

That said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 134. The date of priority is 1907.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficial used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per acre during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in Paragraph 64 of said decree):

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigations purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECTLY IDENTIFY THE CHARACTER OF USE AND SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 5883.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
