CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1.

SOURCE OF WATER: LITTLE APPLGATE RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF APPLGATE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 1.0 ACRE, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: SEPTEMBER 1, 1857

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The types and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.


The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 26, 2002, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 875, approving Transfer Application 8933, and supercedes Certificate 65132, State record of Water Right Certificates.
