confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-6379. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: 7 WELLS IN THE DRY MUDDY CREEK BASIN

PURPOSE or USE: LOG DECK SPRINKLING

MAXIMUM RATE: SHALL NOT EXCEED 0.67 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), FURTHER LIMITED TO 0.65 CFS FROM WELL 1, 0.06 CFS FROM WELL 2, 0.28 CFS FROM WELL 3, 0.16 CFS FROM WELL 4, AND 0.03 CFS FROM WELL 7, IN ANY COMBINATION, OR ITS EQUIVALENT

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 50291 and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 11, 2006, at Special Order Volume 69, Page 48, approving Transfer Application 8042, supercedes Certificate 50291, State record of Water Right Certificates.
