confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH BRANCH TROUT CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 49.1 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Harney County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 89. The date of priority is 1908.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:



The diversion of water shall be contingent upon maintaining an adequate system of drain ditches and controls to prevent the free-flowing of the lands from which the water right is hereby severed.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in the place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 16, 1978, at Special Order Volume 30, Page 276, approving Transfer Application 2660.

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
