CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A HORIZONTAL INFILTRATION GALLERY, for MUNICIPAL USES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9827. The date of priority is JUNE 8, 1982. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, provided that the amount of water allowed herein together with the amount of water allowed under Permit S-46867, shall not exceed 5.93 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

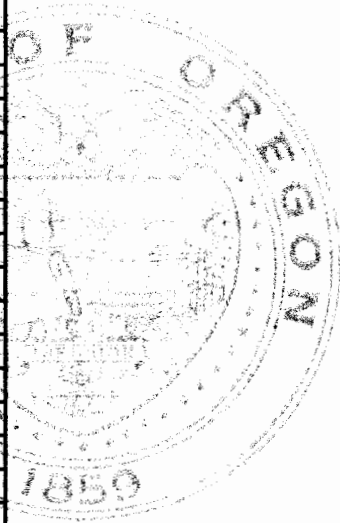
The total amount of water appropriated under this right in combination with the rights developed under permits S-18293, S-37605, and S-46867 shall not exceed 9.56 cfs.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The right shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The water user shall maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The water user shall maintain an in-line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

Water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).
