CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ERNEST JANSSEN
FALL CREEK, OR 97438

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE FALL CREEK, a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of IRRIGATION of 11.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-25307. The date of priority is JANUARY 22, 1958. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.148 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 28220, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 8, 2016, approving Transfer Application T-12195.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
