 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

 3833 HOLLAND LOOP ROAD
 CAVE JUNCTION OR 97523

confirms the right to use the waters of ALTHOUSE CREEK, a tributary to the ILLINOIS RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 17.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC, AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 209. The date of priority is 1883.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.34 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

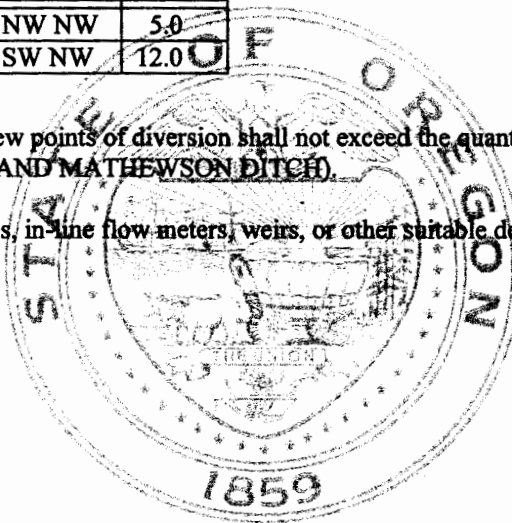

A description of the place of use is as follows:

40 S	8 W	WM	1	NW NW	5.0
40 S	8 W	WM	1	SW NW	12.0

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion (SPENCE AND MATHEWSON DITCH).

The water user shall maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.



NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain fish screen or fish by-pass devices.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 4, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 803, approving Transfer Application 8029, supercedes Certificate 2721, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
