confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH DRAINAGE DITCH AND THE PUDDING RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF THE WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 26.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-20271. The date of priority is MARCH 28, 1951. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, any deficiency in the available supply in the South drainage ditch to be made up by diversion from the Pudding River, providing that the total quantity diverted from both sources shall not exceed one-eightieth cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

6 S	1 W	WM	4	SW SW	1380 FEET SOUTH AND 1050 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 4

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of diversion described as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department

Water shall be acquired from the same surface sources as the original points of diversion.


The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 12, 1999 at Special Order Volume 53, Page 408, approving Transfer Application 7363, and together with Certificate 76023, supercedes Certificate 45427, State record of Water Right Certificates.
