CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KIRTLAND FARMS 600 LLC
 KIRTLAND FARMS 1700 LLC
 3230 KIRTLAND RD
 CENTRAL POINT OR 97502

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 85.5 ACRES AND STOCK USE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-7145. The date of priority is APRIL 25, 1925. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.83 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of diversion as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable measuring device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source or aquifer as the original point of diversion.

The new point of diversion shall retain the original date of priority.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION TO A POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 2, 2005, at Special Order Volume 63, Page 427, approving Transfer Application 9128, supercedes Certificate 8979, State record of Water Right Certificates.
