CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-3387. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: WELL 3A, WELL 3B, WELL 3C, WELL 4A, AND WELL 5A IN ROGUE RIVER BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: MUNICIPAL USE

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.40 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), FURTHER LIMITED TO 0.40 CFS FROM WELL 3A, 0.38 CFS FROM WELL 3B, 0.11 CFS FROM WELL 3C, 0.16 CFS FROM WELL 4A, AND 0.18 CFS FROM WELL 5A, IN ANY COMBINATION NOT TO EXCEED A MAXIMUM RATE OF 0.40 CFS

DATE OF PRIORITY: AUGUST 1, 1966

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (same source) as the original point of appropriation.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation as described as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described; however, water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in POINT OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 21, 2006, at Special Order Volume 68, Page 736, approving Transfer Application 10024, supersedes Certificate 57266, State record of Water Right Certificates.
