CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-3938. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: JOHN DAY RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF COLUMBIA RIVER

PURPOSE or USE: IRRIGATION OF 130.2 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 15.8 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 1.825 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: NOVEMBER 11, 1918

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.


When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to describe the right modified by provisions of an order recorded at Special Order Volume 56, Pages 895-902, diminishing a portion of the right evidenced by Certificate 72942. This certificate supersedes Water Right Certificate 72942.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
