CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-2118. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: BRIDGE CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF THE JOHN DAY RIVER

PURPOSE or USE: IRRIGATION OF 16.2 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.21 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: AUGUST 7, 1914

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 955, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 27, 2002, and recorded in Special Order Volume 56, Page 895, clarifying the place of use, points of diversion, AND a partial cancellation of Certificate 955.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
