The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 19943 and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 13, 2011 at Special Order Volume 84, Page 272, approving Transfer Application 10525, supercedes Certificate 19943, State record of Water Right Certificates.
