CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-35534. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: SECOND CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF CHETCO RIVER

PURPOSE or USE: QUASI-MUNICIPAL USE

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

LIMIT/DUTY: THE USE OF WATER UNDER THIS RIGHT IS LIMITED TO AN ANNUAL VOLUME OF 17.86 ACRE-FEET PER YEAR

DATE OF PRIORITY: AUGUST 18, 1970

The point of diversion is located as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:


- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described; and is subject to all other conditions and limitation contained in Certificate 86738 and any related decree. However, water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 5, 2011, at Special Order Volume 83, Page 963, approving Transfer Application 11175, supercedes Certificate 86738, State record of Water Right Certificates.
