CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to the use of waters of AN UNNAMED CREEK AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-2299, tributary to the LITTLE PUDDING RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 21.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-31713. The date of priority is MAY 5, 1966. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.22 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

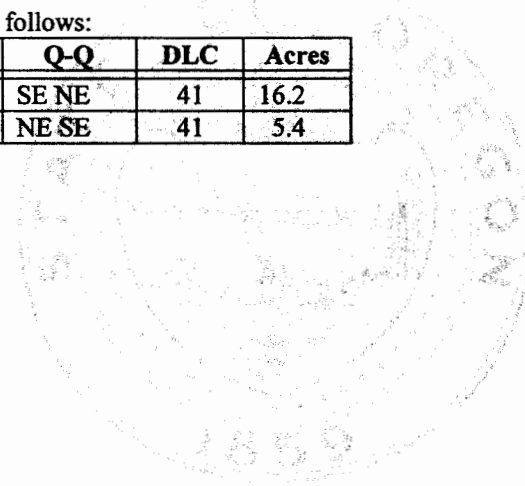
The point of diversion is located as follows:

8 S	2 W	WM	11	NW NE	41	690 FEET SOUTH AND 1070 FEET EAST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 11

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-2299, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 20, 2006, at Special Order Volume 70, Page 230, approving Transfer Application 9821, and together with Certificate 82187, supersedes Certificate 36218, State record of Water Right Certificates.
