 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FRANK L. SHAW  
 SISTERS, OR 97759

confirms the right to use the waters of SQUAW CREEK (now known as Whychus Creek), a tributary of DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 6.88 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 120. The date of priority is 1883.

The use is limited to 0.14 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 67284, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of two orders of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 27 2016, approving Transfer Applications T-11320 and T-11358.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
