CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-5681. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: BRIDGE CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF JOHN DAY RIVER

PURPOSE or USE: IRRIGATION ON 17.8 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.22 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: NOVEMBER 13, 1922

The point of diversion is located as follows:

13 S	28 E	WM	18	SE NE	1650 FEET SOUTH AND 1590 FEET EAST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 18

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The use is required to conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion described as follows:

13 S	28 E	WM	30	NW NW	POD #2 - 310 FEET SOUTH AND 850 FEET WEST FROM W1/16, SECTIONS 19 AND 30

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.


The water user shall maintain a screen or by-pass device, approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife, to prevent fish from entering the diversion.

The water user shall record and report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE, POINT OF DIVERSION, AND CANCELLATION OF A PORTION OF RIGHT approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 27, 2002, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 895, approving Transfer Application 8421, supercedes Certificate 6749, State record of Water Right Certificates.
