CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL NO. 3 in the WILLAMETTE BASIN for NURSERY OPERATIONS, INCLUDING CONTAINERIZED NURSERY STOCK AND GREENHOUSE USE ON 0.83 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10797. The date of priority is OCTOBER 1, 1987. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 9.8 GALLONS PER MINUTE, BEING 2.5 GPM FOR CONTAINERIZED NURSERY STOCK AND 7.3 GPM FOR GREENHOUSE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The water user shall maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The use of water under this right shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights as well as ground water rights of others.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 68768, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered June <u>10</u>, 2016, approving Transfer Application T-12140.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
