This right was perfected under Permit G-10738. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 19, 1986. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 7.0 GALLONS PER MINUTE, BEING 4.5 GPM FROM WELL 1 AND 2.5 GPM FROM WELL 2 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
