CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of WYCHUS CREEK, tributary to DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION of a total of 106.0 ACRES, being 52.0 acres with priority date of 1885 and 54.0 acres with priority date 1900.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1 at Page 120. The dates of priority are 1885 and 1900.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.51 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.76 CFS FOR 1885 PRIORITY DATE AND 0.75 CFS FOR 1900 PRIORITY DATE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of 1/68.4 of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated for the lands with an 1885 priority date, and 1/72 of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated for the lands with a 1900 priority date during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

This certificate is issued to describe the water right confirmed by the Order of Proper Proof of Changes in Place of Use and Point of Diversion Under Transfer 8743, recorded in Special Order Volume 91, Pages 806-807.

The issuance of this certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment after February 13, 2014.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
