confirms the right to store water perfected under the terms of Permit S-30158. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: BUTTE CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF PUDDING RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 42.1 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.53 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: DECEMBER 7, 1964

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen as required by Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 34541 and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE, approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 30, 2004, at Special Order Volume 61, Page 514, approving Transfer Application 7567, and supercedes Certificate 34541, State record of Water Right Certificates.
