confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-25370. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: JOHN DAY RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF THE COLUMBIA RIVER

PURPOSE or USE: IRRIGATION OF 2.6 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: FEBRUARY 28, 1958

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
13 S	31 E	WM	19	SE SW	1820 FEET SOUTH AND 30 FEET EAST FROM C-W1/16 CORNER, SECTION 19

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre irrigated during April 1 to September 30; further limited to 5.0 acre-feet per acre for the irrigation season, measured at the point of diversion.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

When required by the Department, the water user shall operate the headgate and measuring device, as needed. The water user shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may monitor the accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 9, 2004, at Special Order Volume 61, Page 68, approving Transfer Application 9323, and together with Certificate 80888, supercedes Certificate 56303, State record of Water Right Certificates.
