CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STAN PEICKERT  
 4726 SEVENMILE HILL RD  
 THE DALLES, OR 97058

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the BADGER CREEK (COLUMBIA RIVER) BASIN for IRRIGATION of 1.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6714. The date of priority is MARCH 9, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.016 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

2 N	13 E	WM	19	SW SE	885 FEET NORTH AND 193 FEET EAST FROM THE S¼ CORNER OF SECTION 19

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

2 N	13 E	WM	19	SW SE	630 FEET SOUTH AND 1760 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 19

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 88016, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 27 2016, approving Transfer Application T-12203.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
