The amount of water from the South Umpqua River used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The amount of water from Cow Creek used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SEVENTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The period of allowed use for stored water is April 1 through September 30. The use of waters from live flow is limited to the period April 1 through July 15 of each year.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

A. The Director may require the water user to install meters or other suitable measuring devices as approved by the Director. If the Director notifies the water user to install meters or other measuring devices, the water user shall install such devices within the period stated in the notice. Such installation period shall not be less than 90 days unless special circumstances warrant a shorter installation period. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order and shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative measuring procedures for review and approval.

B. The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the water user to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the right. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The use of water under this right is subject to the terms and conditions of Water Service Contract secured by the Douglas County Water Resources Survey for release of stored water from Galesville Reservoir or a satisfactory replacement by the applicant.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening and by-pass devices as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversions.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

In the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or alteration of the appropriation facility associated with this authorized diversion, the quantity of water allowed herein, together with any other right, shall not exceed the capacity of the facility at the time of perfection of this right.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
