confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-6415. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the wells. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: TWO WELLS IN THE PUDDING RIVER BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 129.9 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: THE COMBINED RATE IS LIMITED TO NO MORE THAN 525 GALLONS PER MINUTE (GPM); BEING 400 GPM FROM WELL #2 AND 125 GPM FROM WELL #1.

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 8, 1975

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:


- A. The water user shall maintain meters or measuring devices in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where any meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- D. The water user may be required to report water use, if needed to help resolve conflicts if undue interference occurs.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 21, 2010, at Special Order Volume 80, Page 691, approving Transfer Application 10567, supercedes Certificate 57090, State record of Water Right Certificates.
