This order confirms the right of record to use the waters of GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary to the SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 40.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1872.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

2 S	38 E	WM	31	SW SW	1858.33 FEET SOUTH AND 80.84 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 31

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right is further limited by the Grande Ronde River Consolidated decree stating that the Orodell Ditch Association is entitled to divert 100 miner's inches between September first of each year and May first of the following year, 500 miner's inches between May first and July first of each year, and 200 miner's inches between July first and September first of each year, but at no time shall said Orodell Ditch Association divert more than half of the flow of the Grande Ronde River.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening and/or by-pass device as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 14, 2014, at Special Order Volume 91, Page 838, approving Transfer Application 11596, and together with Certificate 89097, supercedes Certificate 85560, State record of Water Right Certificates.
