## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-12703. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of appropriation from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: WELL 1 AND WELL 2 IN HARNEY LAKE BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 127.2 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 1.59 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 1.35 CFS FROM WELL 1 AND 0.90 CFS FROM

WELL 2

DATE OF PRIORITY: JUNE 17, 1993

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meters or other suitable measuring devices approved by the Director in good working order at each point of appropriation, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month, and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the water user to report general water-use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the right.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer water source as the original point of appropriation.

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge to determine the water level elevation in the wells at all times.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use, without waste, on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an additional point of appropriation approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 8, 2010, at Special Order Volume 82, Page 68, approving Transfer Application 11033, supersedes Certificate 76299, State record of Water Right Certificates.
