confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit U-711. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the wells. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: TWO WELLS IN PINE CREEK BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 183.7 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 53.1 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: SHALL NOT EXCEED 2.69 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS); FURTHER LIMITED TO 1.0 CFS FROM THE ADDITIONAL WELL, IN ANY COMBINATION

DATE OF PRIORITY: MARCH 4, 1955

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation shall not exceed 3.09 cubic feet per second.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 7, 1990 at Special Order Volume 44, Page 118, approving Transfer Application 6241, supercedes Certificate 30531, State record of Water Right Certificates.
