CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-29084. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: UMATILLA RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF THE COLUMBIA RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: USE IN HOLDING AND SPAWNING FACILITIES

MAXIMUM RATE: 13.4 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

PERIOD OF USE: SEPTEMBER 15 TO JULY 15 OF EACH YEAR

DATE OF PRIORITY: AUGUST 14, 1963

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Permit 29084 shall be subordinate and inferior to all future appropriations on the Umatilla River filed after August 14, 1963 for municipal, domestic and irrigations purposes.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in USE, PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 6, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 825, approving Transfer Application 7627, and together with Certificate 77029, supercedes Certificate 34390, State record of Water Right Certificates.
