CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to the use of waters of TWO WELLS, in the LITTLE PUDDING RIVER BASIN, tributary to the PUDDING RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 26.8 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit G-124. The date of priority is January 10, 1956. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.34 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.


When required by the Department the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the water source (alluvial sand and gravels) as the original points of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described, subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 24371 and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 9, 2005, at Special Order Volume 62, Page 251, approving Transfer Application 9774, supersedes Certificate 24371, State record of Water Right Certificates.
