CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-7900. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: TWO WELLS IN THE NORTH SANTIAM RIVER BASIN

PURPOSE or USE: INDUSTRIAL USE

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.71 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS); FURTHER LIMITED TO 0.45 CFS FROM WELL 2, IN ANY COMBINATION

DATE OF PRIORITY: DECEMBER 16, 1977

The wells are located as follows:

The right shall be limited to the appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Water for the new well shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device at the existing authorized point of appropriation (Well #1) and the new point of appropriation (Well #2) for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 53879 and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 2, 2007, at Special Order Volume 71, Page 18, approving Transfer Application 10119, supercedes Certificate 53879, State record of Water Right Certificates.
