CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of HORSE HAVEN (HORSE HEAVEN) CREEK AND MEADOW BRANCH OF HORSE HAVEN (HORSE HEAVEN) CREEK , tributary to the CROOKED RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 17.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-2490. The date of priority is APRIL 13, 1915. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.21 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


