confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 14, at Page 498.

SOURCE OF WATER: SOUTH FORK LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF LITTLE BUTTE CREEK

PURPOSE or USE: IRRIGATION OF 9.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.21 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, MEASURED AT THE HEAD OF THE DITCH OR THE POINT WHERE THE SAME LEAVES THE NATURAL STREAM

PERIOD OF USE: APRIL 1 TO OCTOBER 1

DATE OF PRIORITY: MAY 1, 1900

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 28, 2010, at Special Order Volume 83, Page 264, approving Transfer Application 11128, and together with Certificate 86782, supercedes Certificate 17177, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
