CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit E-134. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: JOHN DAY RIVER, TRIBUTARY OF THE COLUMBIA RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 5.1 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.064 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 1, 1912

The point of diversion is located as follows:

| 13 S | 29 E | WM  | 24  | NW SE | 1990 FEET NORTH AND 1430 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 24 |

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 31, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 815, approving Transfer Application 8445, and together with Certificate 77014, and Transfer T-8475, supercedes Certificate 52024, State record of Water Right Certificates.
