CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the waters of LOG YARD WELL, in the WHITE RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 56.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6945. The date of priority is JULY 28, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.71 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of March 1 through October 31 of each calendar year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND A CHANGE IN CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 17, 2003, at Special Order Volume 58, Page 303, approving Transfer Application 6789, and supercedes Certificate 47965, State record of Water Right Certificates.
