confirms the right to use the waters of POWDER RIVER, tributary to SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 11.9 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1906.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.3 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

8 S	40 E	WM	28	SE NW	POINT 29 (TAGGART WEST): 2650 FEET NORTH AND 1650 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 28

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.


The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This order is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 24, 2007, at Special Order Volume 72, Page 138, approving Transfer Application 8446, and together with Certificate 81777, supercedes Certificate 73587, State record of Water Right Certificates.
