CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, TRIBUTARY TO THE COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 72.4 ACRES AND STOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1866.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
13 S	31 E	WM	22	SW SE	1040 FEET NORTH AND 160 FEET EAST FROM S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 22

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to one acre-foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and $\frac{3}{4}$ acre-foot per acre thereafter; total five acre-feet per acre for season, measured at the point of diversion.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original points of diversion.


NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 18, 2005, at Special Order Volume 67, Page 449, approving Transfer Application 6863, and together with Certificate 81728, supercedes Certificate 25927, State record of Water Right Certificates.
