 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM AND CHAROTTE NEELY
 ROUTE 3, BOX 148
 MILTON-FREEWATER, OR 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of SPRING BRANCH, a tributary of the WALLA WALLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION on 10.6 acres and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION on 27.06 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-19303. The date of priority is MARCH 14, 1950. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.68 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of 0.0375 of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.68 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate corrects a scrivener's error in Certificate 88680, which described that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 80905, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 2, 2013, approving Transfer Application T-11144.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
