CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RAYBURN H. WILSON
21107 SPANGLE CREEK RD
SPANGLE WA 99031

confirms the right to use the waters of EAGLE CREEK, tributary to POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION of 7.2 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1903.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.18 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
8 S	45 E	WM	28	SW SW	400 FEET SOUTH FROM NW CORNER, SWSW, SECTION 28

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

8 S	45 E	WM	20	NE NW	30 FEET SOUTH AND 2540 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 20

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 26, 1996, at Special Order Volume 50, Page 91, approving Transfer Application T-7292, and together with Certificate 49635, supercedes Certificate 4724, as modified by T-4565, at Special Order Volume 33, Page 715.
