CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

380 LAKE CREEK LOOP RD

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-31268. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: LOST CREEK AND BRADSHAW RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-4747, TRIBUTARIES OF SOUTH FORK LITTLE BUTTE CREEK

PURPOSE OR USE: QUASI-MUNICIPAL USE

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: JULY 5, 1966

The use from direct flow may only be made during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year. The use from storage may be made any time during the year.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion, described as follows:


When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted at the new and original points of diversion. The types and plans of the headgates and measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning of construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in USE, PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 5, 1996, at Special Order Volume 50, Page 8, approving Transfer Application 7383, and together with Certificate 68739, supercedes Certificate 56183, State record of Water Right Certificates.
