CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT 725 SUMMER STREET NE, SUITE C SALEM, OR 97301

confirms the right to use the waters of SNAKE RIVER, TRIBUTARY TO COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 42.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-31231. The date of priority is JUNE 27, 1966. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.92 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), further limited to 0.33 CFS FROM POD 1 AND 0.67 CFS FROM POD 2, in any combination, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 23, 2007, at Special Order Volume 71, Page 75, approving Transfer Application 10166, and together with Certificate 82742, supercedes Certificate 75566, State record of Water Right Certificates.
