CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-371. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of appropriation from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: TWO WELLS IN CHRISTMAS LAKE VALLEY BASIN

PURPOSE or USE: IRRIGATION OF 58.6 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.73 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS); BEING 0.35 CFS FROM WELL #1 AND 0.38 CFS FROM WELL #2

DATE OF PRIORITY: SEPTEMBER 7, 1956

The wells are located as follows:

26 S	18 E	WM	12	NW SE	WELL #1 - 1356.23 FEET NORTH AND 1368.88 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 12
26 S	18 E	WM	31	NE SE	WELL #2 - 1343.36 FEET NORTH AND 1318.43 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 31

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water that was lawfully available under the transferred rights at the original points of appropriation described as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 1, 2005, at Special Order Volume 63, Page 192, approving Transfer Application 8518, and together with Certificate 80940, supercedes Certificate 30882, State record of Water Right Certificates.
