CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ADALI KELLY ELIZABETH KELLY 1711 SW WAMPLER LANE POWELL BUTTE OR 97753

confirms the right to the use of waters of A WELL, IN THE CROOKED RIVER BASIN, FOR IRRIGATION OF 4.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8720. The date of priority is DECEMBER 11, 1978 FOR IRRIGATION OF 0.7 ACRES AND DECEMBER 28, 1978 FOR IRRIGATION OF 3.6 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.054 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.009 CFS FOR DECEMBER 11, 1978 AND 0.045 FOR DECEMBER 28, 1978, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available for

this portion of the right at the original points of appropriation, described as follows:

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include air lines and pressure gauges or access ports for measuring line adequate to determine water level elevation in the wells at all times.

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be reduced.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 26, 2004, at Special Order Volume 60, Page 797, approving Transfer Application 9333, and together with Certificate 80689, supersedes a portion of Certificate 79681, State record of Water Right Certificates.
