CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM R LAWSON  
REDMOND, OR 97756

confirms the right to use the waters of STRAWBERRY CREEK, a tributary of the JOHN DAY RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 69.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-259. The date of priority is MARCH 5, 1910. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.87 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.87 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officers.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 439, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered Sept. 12, 2016, approving Transfer Application T-12129.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
