CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1.

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 23.8 ACRES, DOMESTIC USE AND STOCK USE IN TRACT 1

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.6 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: 1866

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion together with that diverted at the original point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:

- a. The water user shall maintain a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at the new point of diversion.
- b. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall operate and maintain a fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 1, 2014, at Special Order Volume 92, Page 952, approving Transfer Application 11620, and together with Certificate 89386, and T-11698, supercedes Certificate 56493, State record of Water Right Certificates.
