CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT (HB - 2153)

confirms the right to store the waters of UNNAMED STREAMS, TRIBUTARY OF BERRY CREEK IN HAMILTON RESERVOIR 6 for , LIVESTOCK, FIRE PROTECTION AND FLOOD CONTROL.

The right to store and use water was perfected under Reservoir Application R-75387. The date of priority is JANUARY 1, 1993. The amount of water entitled to be stored and used each year under this right is not more than 0.75 acre feet (AF) in HAMILTON 6 RESERVOIR.


The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, with a minimum diameter of 8", or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary for public safety or to satisfy prior downstream rights as determine by Water Resources Director.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 81452, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 16, 2016, approving Transfer Application T-12149.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use listed above.
