NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device at each point of appropriation. If the Director notifies the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other measuring device, the water user shall install such device specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of appropriation.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described herein.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in PLACE OF USE and CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 17, 2015, at Special Order Volume 98, Page 259, approving Transfer Application 12075, supersedes Certificate 89471, State record of Water Right Certificates.
